The SPCA is happy to welcome new volunteers into the organization once again. Starting in March, we will have orientation dates for general orientation, adoption counseling, and fostering.

Volunteer Orientation Now Open!

General Volunteer Orientation covers SPCA rules and procedures, dog walking and handling, cat socialization, events, and transportation team. The orientation is an hour and includes a tour of the facility. Kids 8 - 15 are welcomed to be volunteers with a parent or guardian who is also a trained volunteer. Kids 16 - 17 may volunteer on their own with a parent signature. Orientation costs are \$25 per adult and \$10 per child.

Adoption Counselor orientation is our biggest need at this time. Adoption Counselors aid the office staff in running the office, which includes greeting the public, adopting out the animals, and answering phones. Adoption Counselors must be 17 years old or older. There is no fee for this Orientation.



Foster Orientation is a thirty minute orientation which goes over the SPCA foster program. Our largest foster needs at this time are people who do not have animals in the home and can care for sick, injured, or unsocialized adult dogs. With kitten season fast approaching we will have a need for people who can care for bottle babies and pregnant or nursing cat and dog moms. There is no fee for Foster Orientation.


ROOSTER & MICKY Submitted by: Joyce Irvine
