CAT WANTS OUTSIDE?



Your cat wants outside, but he keeps getting into trouble? Is your cat sick of quarantining? A good way to help is to build a catio. A catio is an enclosure structure you can build on your patio or outside a window that your cat is able to go inside and outside when they please. Catios help your cat be outside without the worry of him escaping or getting attacked by predators. Bringing the indoors—outdoors. This can enrich an indoor cat's life and make them a happier cat. It can help prevent your cat from interacting with unwanted visitors, which leads to reduction of the chance of your cat getting diseases. Catios also help prevent your unfixed cat from getting pregnant, though please spay and neuter your pets. Catios provide all the scents and exercise your cat craves, making our relationship with our cats more harmonious.

If a catio is not what you are exactly looking for, just simply hanging a bird feeder outside a window can be a great way for your cats to "interact" with the outdoors but still be completely inside your home. Another way to enhance the bird feeder window is to get a window perch for your cat to lay and sit on while they watch their birdie friends. A window perch is also a great way to designate a spot for your cat to sunbathe as well.

VOLUNTEER NEEDS



Our SPCA volunteers have been awesome about walking dogs, socializing cats, and helping in the office. Our foster homes are full. Our transportation needs have been met. There are a few areas of volunteering that we could still use help with. Here are a few of those:

Cat City Morning Cleaning. Every morning a volunteer or a volunteer family come into the SPCA to help ready the healthy cat room for the day. They change out the blankets, fill the food bowls, scoop the litter, sweep the floor, and cuddle the cats. While we have a few awesome volunteers who regularly do this job, there are still a few days each week we need help filling.

Photos. Photos are a huge part in getting our dogs and cats adopted. We have volunteers that regularly snap pictures of the dogs, but we could use a few people to snap photos of our cats and kittens.

Advanced Dog Walkers. It's always a good time walking dogs at the SPCA, but some of our dogs do not get many walks a day due to being "advanced." Norman F. Kruse Park



- · a secluded beach, popular with dog-owners
- if you're in the mood for a walk and a breathtaking view, explore the nature trails through the dunes
- look for the designated area where you can let your dog play off-leash

Nordhouse Dunes



- a very secluded place to explore, camp, and enjoy the beach
- if you intend to camp, be sure to come prepared with a way to properly seal or hang your food
- · dogs must be leashed

Grand Mere State Park



- enjoy a mile of coastline, and nature trails through the dunes
- the shore can be rocky, so bring appropriate footwear
- dogs must be leashed on the beach and hiking trails

- a beach dedicated to dogs, and perfect for swimming
- the park offers full amenities, including a concession stand
- your dog is free to play off-leash




Warren Dunes State Park

- a popular spot for sunbathing, picnicking, and cross-country skiing in the winter




